Rules for TGA Wednesday Night Golf League 2019

These are post-able rounds. Play the ball down unless conditions warrant a change; there will be a notice in the golf shop at registration for days we are playing lift, clean and place. When we do play lift, clean and place, it will be within a club length, no closer to the hole and in the same condition (fairway to fairway, rough to rough).

In the bunkers, if you are in a footprint, wash out or poor rake job, you may place the ball as close as possible away from the condition. Also, if your ball is lying on a root or the root will interfere with your swing (not stance), you may place it as close as possible away from the condition. Check with fellow competitor(s) before taking action in either of these situations.

Please make all putts and finish the hole unless you have reached NET double bogey. If you choose not to finish that hole because you've reached your ESC score, record that hole as -1 point.

You must play with another TGA member to validate your scores for the league. If you play a league round, you should post your 9 hole score (applying ESC as needed) using the kiosk computer, online or with the smart phone app. (We'll be checking!)

Handicaps: Handicap indexes are updated twice/month – on the first and 15 th of the month. Check your index for the course and tees before you play at the kiosk computer in the clubhouse, the GHIN app on your smartphone, or on the [handicap listing pages](#) on the website.

Tees: We will use 3 sets of tees each week; Black, White and Blue. You may play the tees of your choice with the restriction that you must be 65 or older to play the Blacks.

When calculating your handicap for that round;

1. Verify your course handicap for the Tees you are playing.
2. Adjust your handicap for that round based on the chart below.

For instance,

Scoring: All league points will be scored as NET but write down both your gross and net score with a slash mark between them (i.e., 5/4). Please make sure your handwriting is legible. We will use the modified Stableford scoring system for the NET scores on a hole:

5 for Double eagle

4 for Eagle

3 for Birdie

2 for Par

1 for Bogey

-1 for Double Bogey or higher

Score Card:

- Indicate the tee you play from. If you do not indicate which tee you are playing, I will assume you played the Blacks.
- Make sure you print your name legibly and sign your card.
- Write your 9 hole handicap on the card legibly by your name
- Record your points for each hole and add them up for the round total.
- Please write everything legibly!

Record both your Gross and Net score (i.e., 5/4) on the scorecard to minimize scoring/posting errors, or if we need to check after the fact.

Place scorecards in the plastic box on the kiosk computer stand.

Wednesday Night League Standings will be sent out by email and posted on the website.

Playoffs:

First and Second Half: For each half, the 4 golfers with the highest point totals from their 5 best rounds will be included in the Playoff Round for that half. The two players from each half with the highest point total for the playoff round will advance to the Championship Matches at the end of the summer. Should a player make the semifinals in both halves, the next highest scoring player in the second half Playoff Round will receive the fourth spot for the semifinals.

Once all four players are determined, they will play together in the semi-finals. The top two players will play the next week in the finals for the Wednesday Night League Championship.

Note: In the event of a tie for the initial playoff round in the 1st or 2nd Half, as well as the semi-finals, ties will be broken based on a scorecard playoff beginning with the highest points earned on each hole – starting on #9 and working backward to #1. Should the overall Championship round end in a tie after 9 holes, the two players will play “sudden victory” holes until the match is decided.
