

Match Play 2025.

General Info:

- The Gross Bracket was seeded by Handicaps.
- The Net Bracket was divided into two groups and pairings were totally random. The winner of group one will play the winner of group two for the Championship
- Please try to play the matches by the following dates:
 - Round 1 – 4/7
 - Round 2 – 5/4
 - Round 3 – 6/9
 - Round 4 – 7/14
 - Round 5 – 8/11
 - Round 6 – 9/8
- If matches are not played by the above dates and no one has contacted me, I will flip a coin to determine the winner
- Scheduling Communication:
 - It is the responsibility of higher handicap player to initiate the scheduling, however, either player is free to reach out
 - Contact info is attached in the second tab of the spreadsheet, or you can visit the members page on our website (https://tanglewood36.com/?page_id=66)
 - The initial communication should include general availability with 2 or 3 specific options.
 - The gangsoomes are often good times to play matches. We need to stick to the schedule

Payouts:

Payouts will be less this year because there are fewer participants:

Gross Payouts (18 participants):

- 3rd and 4th place: \$20
- 2nd place: \$40
- Winner: \$100

Net Payouts (40 participants):

- 5th thru 8th place: \$20
- 3rd thru 4th place: \$40

- 2nd place: \$90
- Winner: \$150

Handicapping:

- Handicaps for Net match play can be calculated using the GHIN app on your phone the day of the match
 - Handicaps should be calculated based off the lower player.
 - Example: Player A is a 10 handicap. Player B is an 18 handicap. For the match, player B will receive 8 strokes
- Net matches are played from the White tees
- Gross matches are played from the Blue tees
- Please make sure to post your scores
- If a player is 'out of the hole' and does not finish, record "the most likely score"
- If a putt is conceded, CGA match play rules suggest assuming a 1-putt for putts 5' and under, and a 2-putt for anything exceeding 5'.
- If the match ends prior to the completion of 18 holes:
 - If you play the remaining holes, you must record your actual score not to exceed net double bogey
 - If you do NOT play the remaining holes, **net PAR** should be recorded on each hole
